### John 5:3-9

<sup>3</sup> Here a great number of disabled people used to lie-- the blind, the lame, the paralyzed. <sup>5</sup> One who was there had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. <sup>6</sup> When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him, "Do you want to get well?"<sup>7</sup> "Sir," the invalid replied, "I have no one to help me into the pool when the water is stirred. While I am trying to get in, someone else goes down ahead of me."<sup>8</sup> Then Jesus said to him, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk."<sup>9</sup> At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked. The day on which this took place was a Sabbath.
